CURATOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a. Submit a written proposal that includes exhibition theme, concept, and overall gallery presentation.
- b. Plan, coordinate, produce, and curate exhibition with a timeline as well as ancillary activities according to approved proposal.
- c. Contact, select, and provide guidance as well as direction to participating artists.
- d. Prepare and gather all necessary/required documentation that will accompany the exhibition that includes artists statements.
- e. Hold a mandatory meeting with the artists at MCCLA to discuss important dates, and other important information regarding the exhibit.
- f. Work with Events and Gallery Coordinator to prepare press release, wall signage, gallery program, and guided tours (if applicable).

MCCLA WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- a. \$1,500 Curatorial fee
- b. Gallery space and wall preparation
- c. Gallery staffing/ volunteers
- d. Exhibition materials and supplies as agreed
- e. Professional promotion of the exhibition
